



## Social Story

A visual guide to attending a  
performance in the Cheddington Village Hall

I am going to the Cheddington Village Hall to see a show.



I can get to the hall in a car and park in the car park or walk down the path.



I will walk inside of the hall or use the ramp up to the front door.

I will enter the foyer which looks like this.

It will look slightly different when I get there.



To the left as I come in is where I can find the toilets. These can be used at any time during, before and after the performance.



To the right as I come in is where I can find the bar where I can get something to eat or drink.

I need to show my ticket before I can come in here.



If the performance becomes too much for me I can come in here and regulate myself at any time.

When I am ready to watch the performance I go to the box office. I might have an e-ticket or I might have a paper ticket. I may have to wait in line.



An member of the Front of House team will check my ticket and be able to answer any questions I may have.

I can choose where I want to sit in the hall.  
I can ask a member of the front of house team if I need help.



To get to my seat, I may walk in front of other people, and other people may walk in front of me to get to their seats. People might accidentally bump me whilst they walk by me.

During this special visit, if I need a movement break, I can get up and walk around the back of the hall.



When the show is about to start the hall will get dark and everyone will be quiet.



If there is an emergency I need to follow these signs.



Before the performance begins the actors will introduce themselves, tell you who they will be playing and tell you a bit about their character.



During the performance, some of the actors may enter and exit the stage through the audience.

I don't have to worry as they will not touch me and I will not touch them.



At the end of the show people will clap. This tells the actors we liked the show. I can clap if I want to.



After the show I will go back out of the hall the way I came in.
